## East Coast Highway and Marguerite Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation C-7807-2

Dear Residents/Business Owners:

The City awarded a construction contract to All American Asphalt for the rehabilitation of East Coast Highway from MacArthur Boulevard to Newport Coast Drive and Marguerite Avenue from Bayside Drive to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Refer to the reverse side for a map of the project limits. The proposed improvements include replacing deteriorated concrete improvements, cold milling and overlaying the asphalt pavement, traffic signing and striping, utility adjustments, and other incidental items of work as required.

The contractor is scheduled to start construction on January 24, 2022. Concrete improvements (sidewalks and curbs) will be the first order of work. The asphalt paving operation will follow in April. Following the paving operation, minor appurtenant work, such as traffic striping and utility adjustments, will be performed. If inclement weather is encountered, the contractor will be allowed additional time to complete the project. Daytime working hours are 7:00AM to 4:30PM, Monday through Friday for concrete work. Nighttime working hours are 9:00PM to 6:00AM, Sunday night through Friday for asphalt paving work on East Coast Highway. Asphalt paving operation on Marguerite Ave will be completed during daytime.

Traffic restrictions at and adjacent to the work locations will be required. "No Parking, Tow-Away" signs will be posted warning vehicles parked within the construction area will be towed away. Traffic lane closures and full road closures with detours will be required to facilitate construction. We request that you observe these restrictions and any other traffic controls in the area.

Exercise caution when driving and/or walking through the construction zones. Additionally, heavy equipment and construction materials tend to attract the interest of small children. Please instruct children to stay clear of all construction activities to avoid the potential for injury. Most importantly, notify us of any problems so that we can respond accordingly.

The City's street sweeping will continue on its normal schedule.
