Orange County Supervisor Katrina Foley proudly serves the "Fabulous Fifth" Supervisorial District. Vice Chair Katrina Foley was elected to the Board of Supervisors in 2021 and represents the newly established District 5, which includes the cities of Aliso Viejo, Costa Mesa, Dana Point, a large portion of Irvine, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Laguna Woods, Newport Beach, San Clemente, San Juan Capistrano, as well as the unincorporated areas of Coto de Caza, Emerald Bay, Ladera Ranch, Las Flores, Rancho Mission Viejo, Stonecliffe and Wagon Wheel. This is her second term on the Board of Supervisors, where she previously served District 2 prior to redistricting.

As Vice Chair of the County Board of Supervisors, Supervisor Foley is committed to ensuring safe neighborhoods, reducing homelessness,
